

Result of Analysis

Student Feedback regarding curriculum and infrastructure (2022-23)

The college aims to offer the best possible learning environment to the students in order to enable them to develop full potential. Students feedback related to curriculum as well as infrastructure is very significant to enhance the quality of teaching and learning experience. Feedback from students allow them the opportunities to comment on various aspects of curriculum and infrastructure this provides up with valuable suggestions for further improvements.

Methodology

Feedback from students on curriculum and infrastructure was obtained through structured questioner which included 10 questions in various aspects.

A Five-point Likert scale is used with Weights assigned from 1 to 5 to different levels as follow.

1. Strongly disagree
2. Disagree
3. Neutral
4. Agree
5. Strongly Agree

The range of each order and level is determine by the following formula

(Highestpoint in Likert scale – Lowest Point in Likert Scale) / Number of Levels)

There for Range = $(5-1)/5=4/5=0.8$

Range for Strongly Disagree= (1.0 to 1.8)

Range for Disagree= (1.8 to 2.6)

Rane for Neutral = (2.6 to 3.4)

Range for Agree= (3.4 to 4.2)

Range for Strongly Agree= (4.2 to 5.0)

Data Analysis and Interpretation

Following is the tabular analysis of each question showing number of students' responses on five points Likert Scale. Percentage of students' responses, weighted score and weighted mean score on each question

Question No. (1) The curriculum covers the relevant topics for the assigned subject.

Table 1. shows that out of 721 students surveyed. 141 i.e. 19.56% of students strongly agree that the curriculum cover the relevant topic for assigned subjects, 490 i.e. 67.97% of students agree for the same, 80 i.e. 11.9%, students views are neutral, 4 i.e. 0.55% students are disagree and 6 i.e. 0.83% students are strongly disagree that the curriculum covers the relevant topic for the assignment subjects.

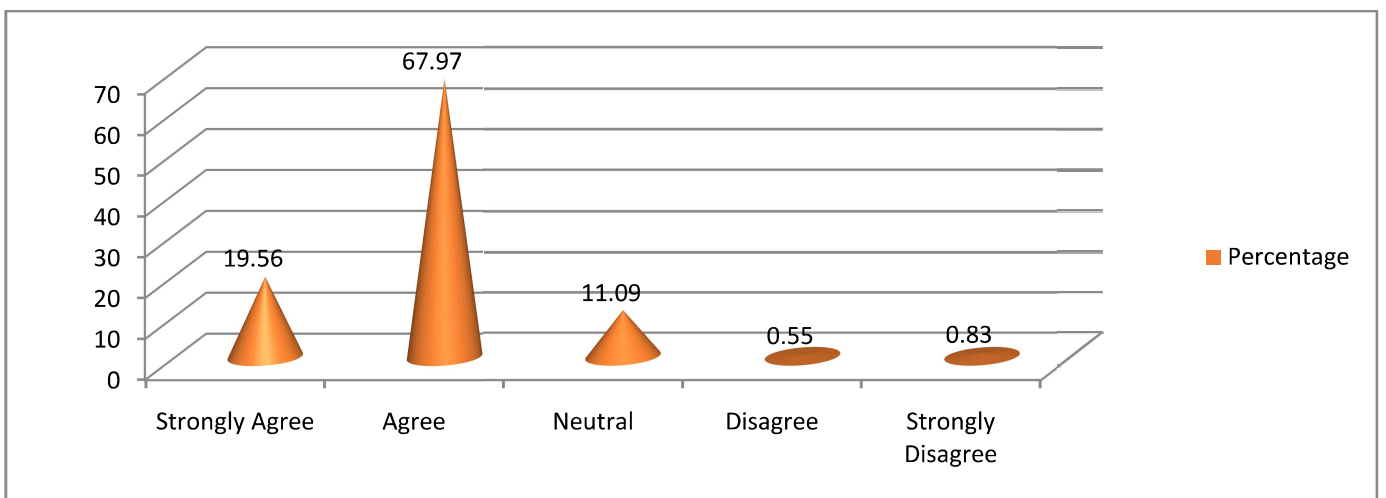


Fig 1 . Percentage of responses on basis that the curriculum covers the relevant topics for the assigned subject.

The results of Question 1 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.1

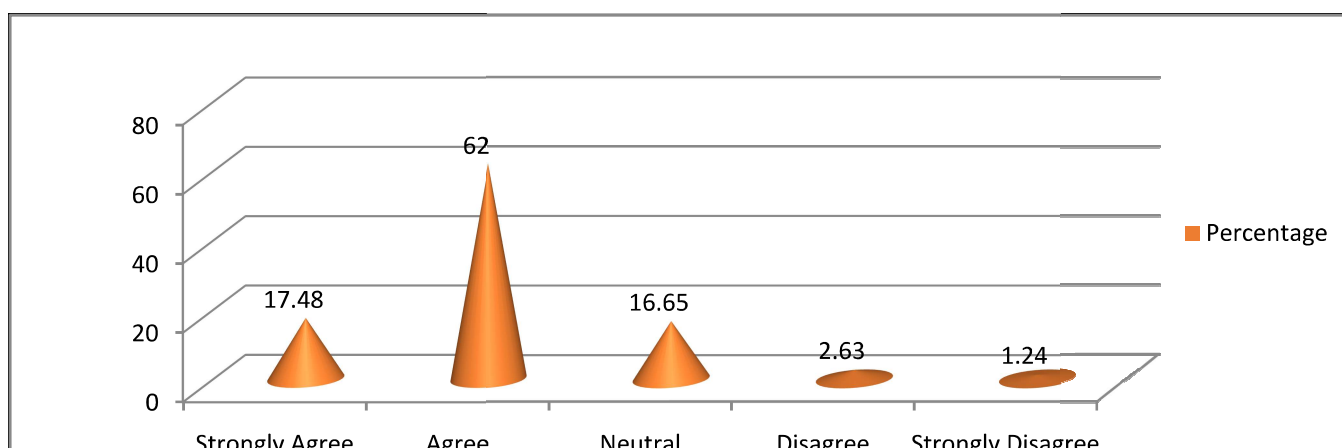


Fig 2. Percentage of responses on the basis that the entire syllabus is covered in the allotted time period.

The results Question 2 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.2

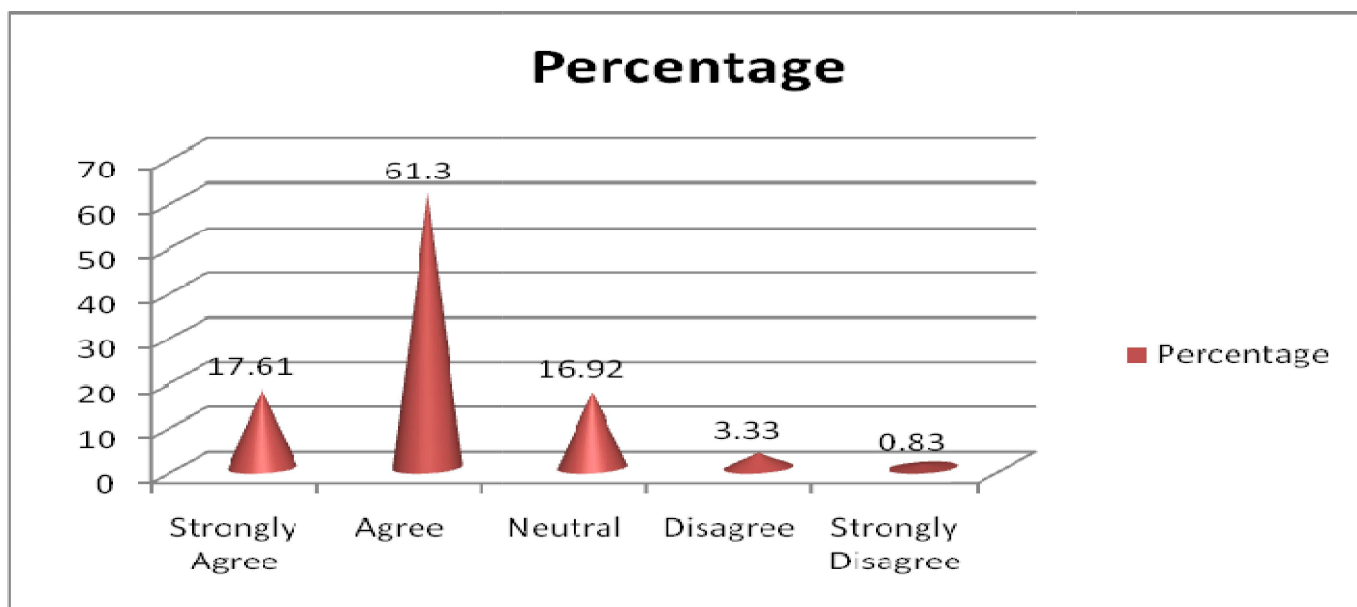


Fig 3. Percentage of responses on the basis that Recent advancements are regularly upgraded and added in the curriculum.

The results Question 3 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.3

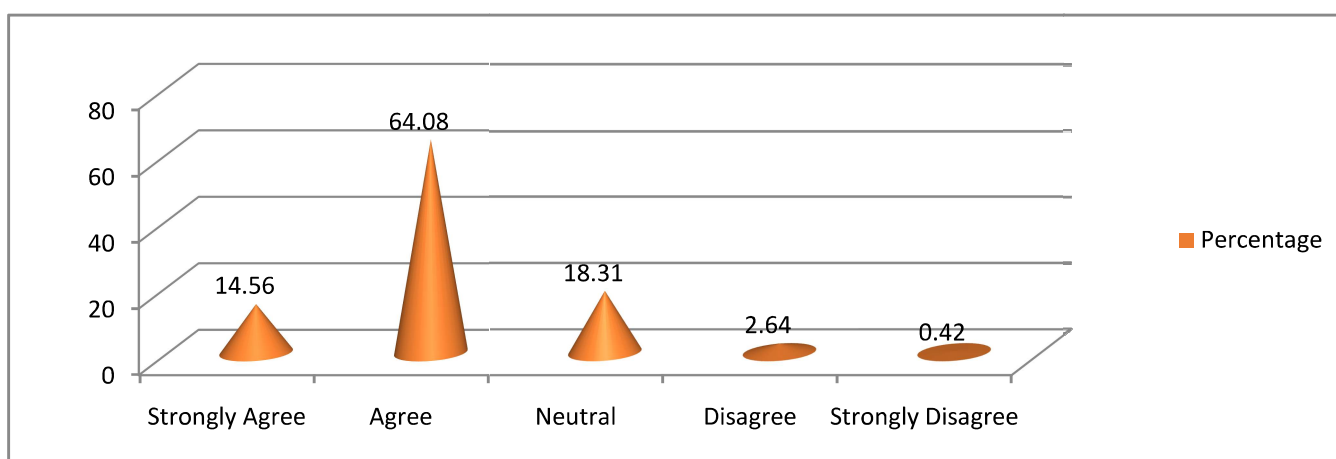


Fig 4. Percentage of responses on the basis that curriculum is helpful in enhancing your knowledge as well as skills and competency.

The results Question 4 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.4

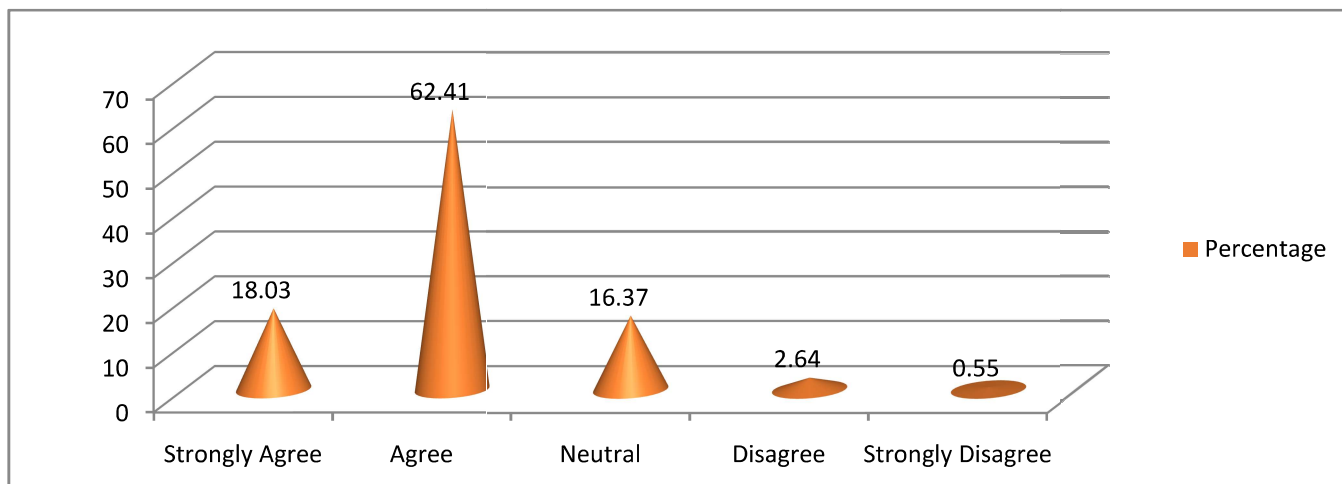


Fig 5. Percentage of responses on the basis that curriculum gives adequate weightage to theory and applied knowledge.

The results Question 5 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.5

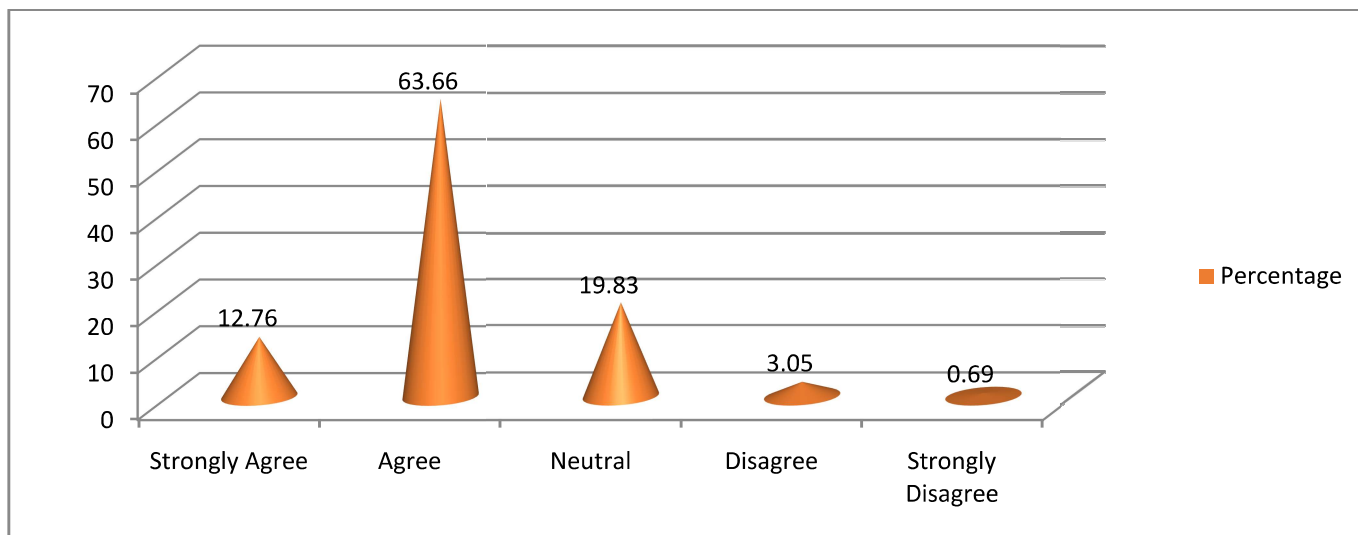


Fig 6. Percentage of responses on the basis of that syllabus is structured to enhance the employability skills of the students.

The results Question 6 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.6

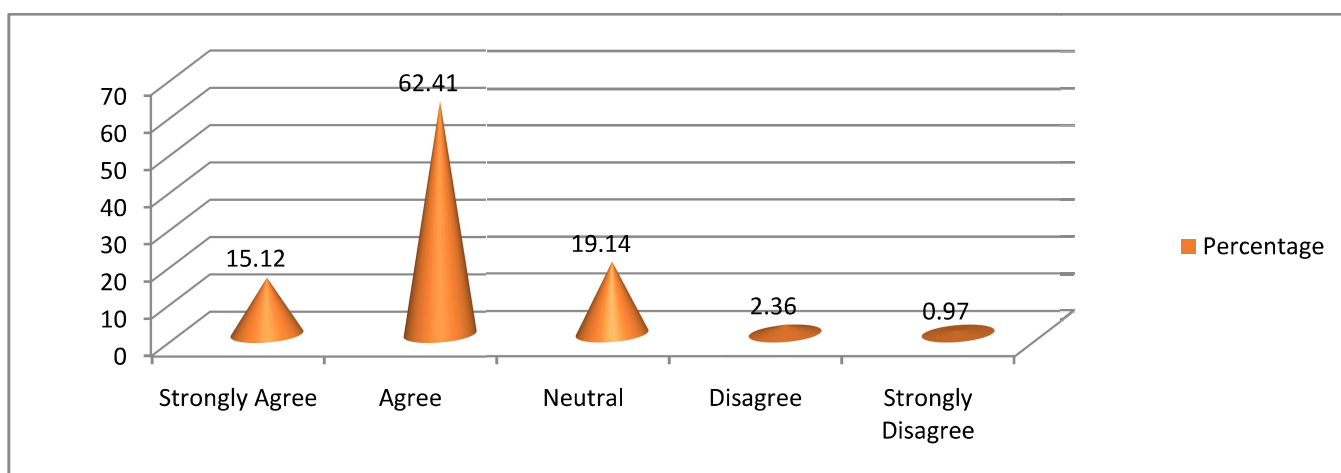


Fig 7. Percentage of responses on the basis of that College library has sufficient books and reference material to cover the topics of syllabus.

The results Question 7 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.7

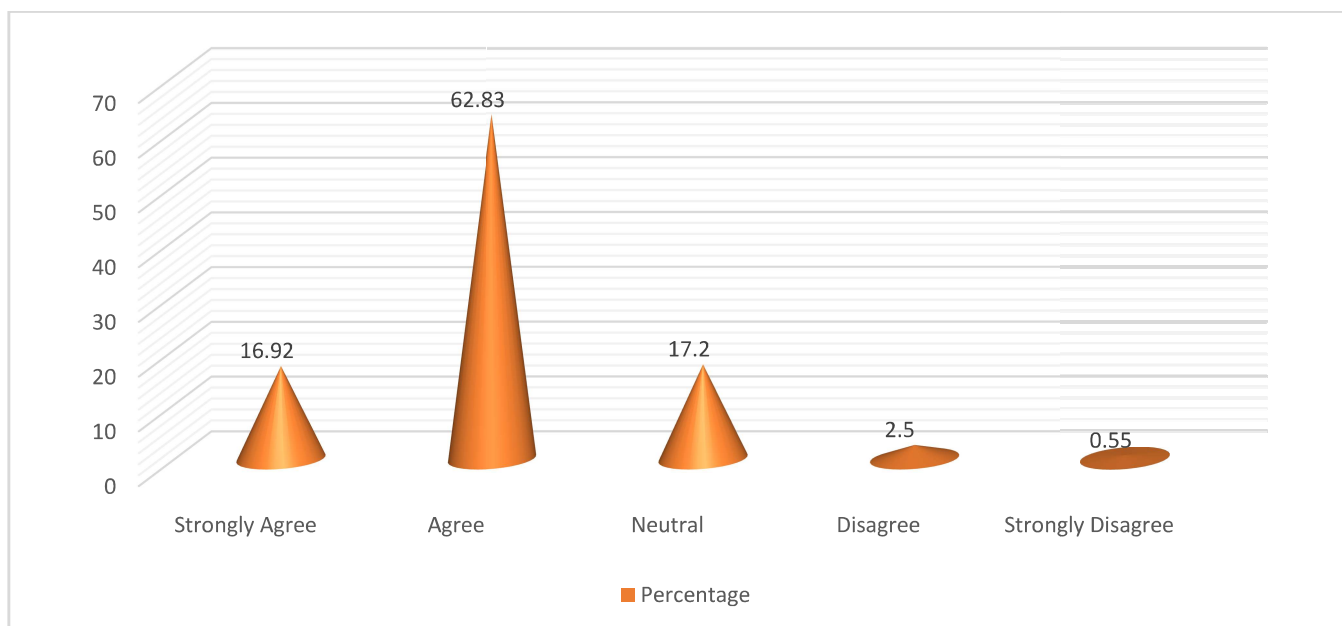


Fig 8. Percentage of responses on the basis of that College library has adequate E- Based Resources.

The results Question 8 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.8

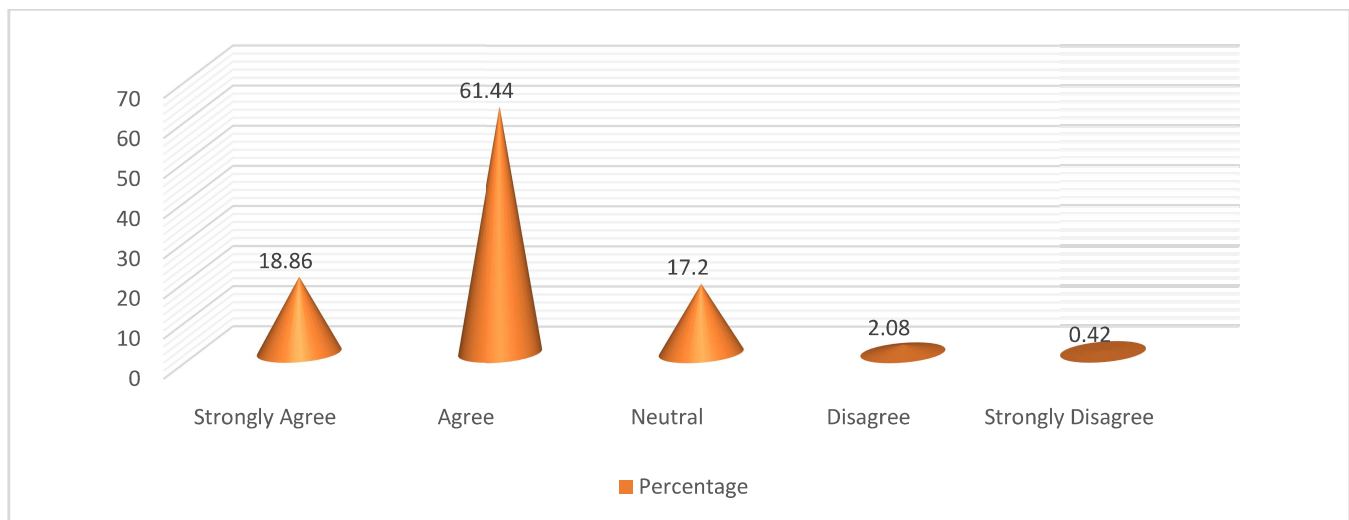


Fig 9. Percentage of responses on the basis that institute has sufficient ICT facilities.

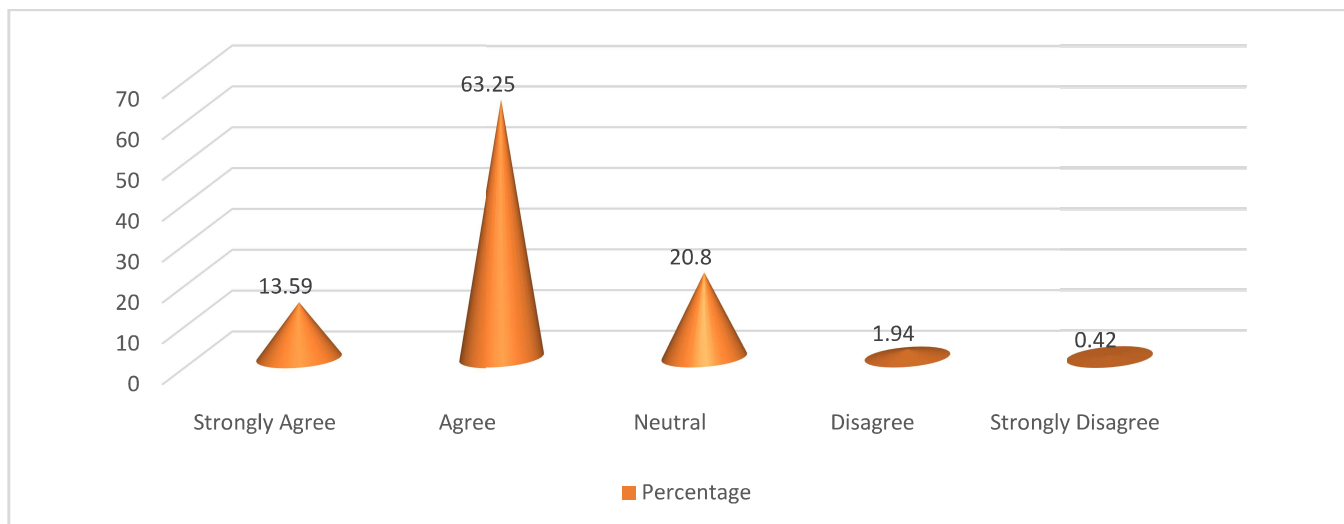


Fig 10. Percentage of responses on the basis of that teachers encourage students to active participative learning.

The results Question 10 are presented below in the diagram as shown fig.10

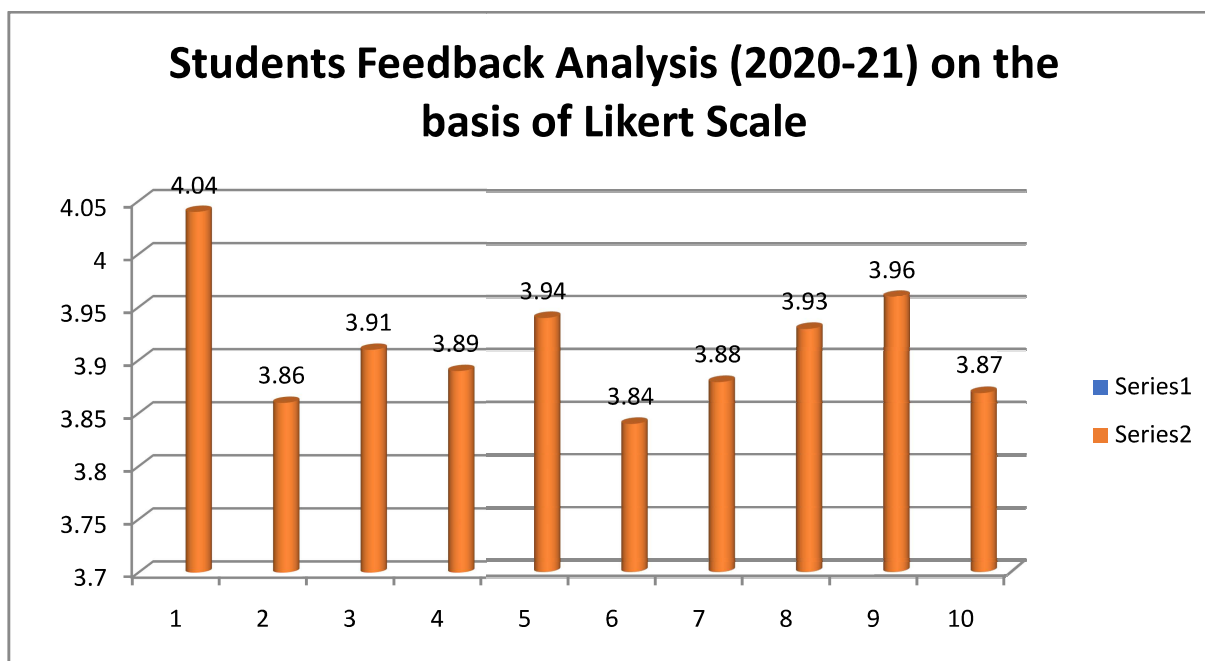


Fig 11. Weighted Mean Score
